HB 2183 B	Relating to reporting of child abuse.	Creates offense of making a false report of child abuse.	07/06/2011
HB 2612	Relating to deposits of public funds.	Specifies that limit on aggregate amount of public funds deposits that may be held by depository applies only to uninsured public funds.	05/12/2011
HB 2613	Relating to deposits of public funds.	Allows deposit of public funds in Oregon depository in amount in excess of statutory limit if Oregon depository redeposits funds into insured deposit accounts in other financial institutions, redeposited funds are federally insured and Oregon depository receives amount of deposits from other financial institutions in at least equal amount.	06/23/2011
HB 2614 A	Relating to banking; and declaring an emergency.	Removes requirement that institution reduce book value of real estate that institution holds under certain provision of law by certain amount each year.	06/23/2011
HB 2622 A	Relating to renewable portfolio standard.	Specifies that, when facility that burned coal as fuel source completely ceases to burn coal and converts to generating electricity from renewable energy source after effective date of Act, facility may use electricity from renewable energy source to comply with renewable portfolio standard.	06/02/2011
HB 2633 A	Relating to alcoholic beverages.	Requires that winery licensee possess federal permit allowing licensee to engage in certain activities.	06/16/2011
HB 2652 A	Relating to persons who can serve in representative capacity for other persons; and declaring an emergency.	Disqualifies person from serving as fiduciary, health care representative, attorney-in-fact or surrogate if prior court order terminated parental rights of person or determined it unsafe for protected person, principal, child, youth or youth offender, while ward of court, to return to person's home.	06/01/2011
HB 2700 B	Relating to removal-fill permitting program; and declaring an emergency.	Allows person that proposes removal or fill activity for construction or maintenance of linear facility to apply for removal or fill permit.	06/16/2011
HB 3034 A	Relating to jury service.	Provides that judge or clerk may defer jury service for person more than once only for good cause.	06/16/2011
HB 3181 A	Relating to the Oregon Board of Accountancy.	Modifies statutes relating to expiration of permits and inactive status for accountants.	05/16/2011
HB 3457 A	Relating to the use of smoking instruments in scripted productions; and declaring an emergency.	Allows performer in scripted stage, motion picture or television production to smoke or carry lighted smoking instrument that does not contain tobacco in public place or place of employment in certain circumstances.	06/02/2011
HB 3579 A	Relating to the advertisement of motor vehicles.	Prohibits advertising that seller will value property being offered as payment toward purchase or lease of motor vehicle at certain amounts.	05/16/2011
HB 3591 A	Relating to economic impacts of water quality variances.	Requires Department of Environmental Quality to consult with applicant regarding Federal Water Pollution Control Act variances in order to seek to minimize negative economic impacts of variances.	06/17/2011
HB 3601	Relating to mining.	Provides that Department of State Lands and State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries may enter into memorandum of agreement in certain cases involving surface mining so that sole responsibility for permitting is assigned to State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries.	06/17/2011
SB 444 A	Relating to alcoholic beverages; and declaring an emergency.	Expands exemption of homemade beer, wine and fermented fruit juice from Liquor Control Act.	03/28/2011
SB 782	Relating to eligibility for unemployment insurance benefits; and declaring an emergency.	Requires supervisory authority of county to forward to Employment Department certain information of defendant committed to supervisory authority.	05/19/2011
