HB 2019 A	Relating to the Oregon National Guard; and declaring an emergency.	Provides that Adjutant General may not place or retain person in unit designated for active federal service outside state if person is sibling of person killed while serving on active duty with Armed Forces of United States.	06/17/2011
HB 2020 B	Relating to state agency employees; and declaring an emergency.	Directs Oregon Department of Administrative Services to report to Joint Committee on Ways and Means ratio of public employees to supervisory employees, ratio of public employees to managerial employees and number of positions for managerial employees who do not act in supervisory capacity.	07/06/2011
HB 2185	Relating to the Wilbur C. Moore Bridge.	Designates bridge across Euchre Creek on U.S. Highway 101 near milepost 317 as Wilbur C. Moore Bridge.	06/21/2011
HB 2840	Relating to green jobs in forest products industries.	Expands green jobs growth initiative to include analysis of growth factors and employment projections for green jobs in forest products industries.	06/21/2011
HB 2908 A	Relating to pelvic examinations.	Prohibits person from knowingly performing pelvic examination on anesthetized or unconscious woman unless woman, or person authorized to make health care decisions for woman, has given informed consent to examination, court orders performance of examination for collection of evidence or examination is necessary for diagnostic purposes.	06/01/2011
HB 3030 A	Relating to volunteer golf course marshals.	Exempts certain individuals providing volunteer golf course marshal services from minimum wage standards .	06/16/2011
HB 3037 A	Relating to senior services.	Specifies that services provided to seniors through Oregon Project Independence include support for community caregivers, health promotion services, options counseling and transportation services.	06/01/2011
HB 3041	Relating to forfeiture; and declaring an emergency.	Authorizes district attorney to file petition in criminal case, on behalf of county or animal care agency, seeking forfeiture of animals alleged to have been abused.	06/21/2011
HB 3042	Relating to the use of alcoholic beverages for educational purposes; and declaring an emergency.	Provides that charging or payment of tuition or fee for food or beverage career program class, or for workshop or seminar concerning food or beverage industry training, that is offered by education provider and includes consumption of alcoholic beverages is not sale or purchase of alcoholic beverages.	06/16/2011
HB 3273 A	Relating to address on Department of Transportation records.	Allows household member to continue to use confidential address on records maintained by Department of Transportation for up to four years after eligible employee or corrections officer is killed in line of duty.	06/09/2011
HB 3354 A	Relating to U.S. Highway 30.	Provides that U.S. Highway 30 between St. Helens and Rainier shall be known as Police Chief Ralph Painter Memorial Highway.	06/21/2011
HB 3416 B	Relating to a memorial to Oregon's World War II veterans; and declaring an emergency.	Establishes World War II Memorial Task Force to solicit private funding and arrange for development, design and construction of memorial to honor Oregon's World War II veterans.	06/21/2011
HB 3500	Relating to the Oregon Military Department; and declaring an emergency.	Directs Oregon Military Department to report to legislative committee on existing military cultural barriers that discourage service members from identifying barriers to reintegration into civilian life.	05/19/2011
HB 3611 A	Relating to death certificates.	Requires person who submits death certificate after decedent's death was caused by suicide to make reasonable efforts to ascertain and to notify Center for Health Statistics whether decedent was veteran, whether decedent served in combat and where decedent served if decedent served in combat.	06/17/2011
HB 3616 A	Relating to health insurance coverage of mastectomy.	Defines "mastectomy" for purposes of statute requiring health benefit plan coverage of mastectomy and services related to mastectomy.	06/01/2011
SB 637	Relating to extended benefit periods; and declaring an emergency.	Provides for state "on" indicator for any week when rate of insured unemployment is at least 6.5 percent and average rate of total unemployment in Oregon for most recent three-month period is at least 110 percent of average for any corresponding three-month period ending in three preceding years.	03/24/2011
SB 638	Relating to extension of unemployment insurance benefits; and declaring an emergency.	Provides for payment of Oregon emergency benefits to qualifying individuals during emergency benefit period.	03/24/2011
SB 746 A	Relating to child welfare services; and declaring an emergency.	Requires members of sensitive review committee to develop findings and conclusions and make recommendations to Director of Human Services regarding policies and practices.	06/17/2011
SB 748 A	Relating to qualifications of persons involved in child abuse investigations.	Requires person conducting child abuse investigation or making determination that child should be taken into protective custody and not returned to parent or responsible person to have advanced educational degree.	06/17/2011
SB 809	Relating to Edward Dickinson Baker.	Designates February 24 of each year as Edward Dickinson Baker Day in Oregon.	05/19/2011
SB 976 A	Relating to a law enforcement medal of ultimate sacrifice.	Establishes Law Enforcement Medal of Ultimate Sacrifice and creates procedure for awarding medal to family of law enforcement officer who died while performing duties or was killed because of employment as law enforcement officer.	06/17/2011
